Please find the enclosed provisional license certificate for tissue bank operation for the following location:



The provisional license is effective until either February 1, 2010 or the issuance of a full license following an on-site survey of your tissue bank. The certificate must be posted conspicuously. Approval as a comprehensive tissue procurement service and tissue processing facility is limited to recovery, processing, storage and distribution of cardiovascular tissue and musculoskeletal tissue. The license is limited to tissue banking activities performed directly by Osteotech, Inc.

In accordance with the provisions of 10 NYCRR 52-3.7(d), the Department will require an annual summary of the activities of your tissue bank. Information to be reported may include the numbers of tissue donors and donations, numbers of tests for various infectious diseases, numbers of tissue units processed and distributed and outcomes of tissue transplantation reported by client facilities. Report changes in direct or indirect ownership of the facility within thirty (30) days of the change. Report changes in director within five (5) days and keep the department informed of any relocations of facilities.
